# Title: Hacking Global Pop Icons

## Dates: 5–9 August (online) 12–23 August (face to face)

### Location: Hong Kong

The sixth edition of the Hacking Global Pop Icons summer school continues the legacy from the previous editions' format. Students will choose a pop icon as a common starting point for cultural analysis and create creative works and interventions in the form of a pop-up event.

The summer school will take place at Hong Kong Baptist University. Students from partner universities in both Europe and Asia, spanning various creative disciplines such as contemporary art, film, pop music, sound design, product design, spatial design, comics and illustration, curatorial practice, cultural studies, and more, will collaborate and learn from each other. Faculty members from the shared campus network will provide guidance.

Past pop icons selected for analysis and creative exploration in previous editions of the summer school include Tinder (the dating app), Greta Thunberg (the environmental activist), Billie Eilish (singer and songwriter), NFTs, and the Ocean.

- Examine how global icons interact with and are shaped by digital monism
- Experience practice-based transcultural and transdisciplinary creative collaboration
- Discuss and apply media representation theory
- Develop presentation skills
